Project Goal: The ability of children and their communities in Khulna City Corporation has enhanced capacity to respond to climate change is enhanced and sustained through strengthened sub-national processes, systems and national level advocacy.

Objectives:

1. Child-centered and disability inclusive climate change adaptation assessments, tools and planning processes are established and strengthened at community and school level.
2. The capacity of the sub-national government to support local climate change risks and vulnerabilities is increased through the development and strengthening of tools and planning processes.
3. Sub-national governments in targeted areas are engaged in local level adaptation planning and have the tools to mobilize resources to support priority adaptation measures.
4. Sensitized national level government to incorporate child sensitive CCA in their plans, platforms and actions.



Activities:

Activity under objective 1

- Sessions are conducted with 360 community people on child centered climate change adaptation and resilience
- Sessions are conducted with 180 community children on climate change adaptation and resilience
- Sessions are conducted on 180 youth on DRR & CCA and eco-friendly life living
- Trainings/refresher trainings are conducted with 90 youth on DRR and CCA and eco-friendly life living
- Child and climate sensitive CRA/URA conduction/review workshop are organized with 3 communities by 2018
- Class sessions are conducted with 5,040 school children on DRR and CCA at 12 schools by 2021
- Meeting are conducted with 300 green club members at school on DRR and CCA by 2021
- Contributing to annual school sports competition at schools to disseminate DRR and CCA information through quizzes, debates, games etc.
- Trainings are conducted to increase capacity to develop child and climate sensitive school safety plan by engaging students, teachers and SMCs by 2019
- Schools develop child and climate sensitive school safety plans by engaging students, teachers and SMCs by 2019
- Validation workshop of school safety plans by SMCs and related local stakeholders at union/Upazila level by 2019
- School safety plan findings are implemented by SMCs for targeted schools and by education authorities for required schools to create clean, green and safe school by 2021
- Arrangement 12 mock drills at school level to increase knowledge and skill on disaster preparedness



- Day observations (International Day for Disaster Risk, National Disaster Preparedness Day, World Environment Day etc.) to increase knowledge and engage community people, youth and children on DRR and CCA
- Trainings are organized with 60 children with disabilities (CWD), people with disability (PWD) and caregivers on child rights, child participation, DRR & CCA and resilience by 2021
- Research conducted to find climate change adaptive options to create climate smart community
- Informing communities of climate change adaptive options to practice and create climate smart community

- Validation workshop on child and climate sensitive community risk assessment are organized with UDMC/WDMC at union/ward level by 2018

- Regular meetings are conducted with 3 UDMC/WDMC on DRR and CCA to incorporate child and climate sensitive adaptation findings in annual development plan (ADP)
- Regular meetings are conducted with 3 UzDMC/Zonal DMC on DRR and CCA to incorporate child and climate sensitive adaptation findings in annual development plan
- Campaign on clean, green and safe school organize in 3 districts in through green clubs, SMCs and education authorities by 2021
